RESPONSIBILITIES

Duties include but are not limited to:-

Team Manager / Team Leader

- Provide direction and support to the Team
- Serve as the main point of contact
- Communicate effectively with players, parents, Team Officials and EC Members.
- Resolve any conflicts or issues relating to the Event
- Promote teamwork and collaboration
- Handle National Anthem & Regional Flag properly
- Post Event evaluation/assessment report to EC
- Perform any other appropriate duties as assigned by EC or required by IIHF

Team Doctor / Team Physiotherapist

- Conduct medical assessments
- Mange injuries and provide emergency care
- Accompany team
- Maintain accurate medical records of each player
- Document injuries, treatment and recovery progress
- Health Education if needed
- Perform any other appropriate duties as assigned by EC or required by IIHF

Coach(es)

- Provide training programme for the Men's Team
- Manage practices / games / off ice sessions / classroom sessions
- Consider / Plan pre-tournament overseas camp (possibly days leading to Event)
- Communicate effectively with players, parents and EC Members.
- Promote sportsmanship, teamwork and personal development.
- Post Event Player evaluation/assessment
- Be a role model, exemplifying professionalism, integrity and sportsmanship at all times, both on and off the ice, to serve as a positive role model for the players
- Perform any other appropriate duties as assigned by EC or required by IIHF

Equipment Manager

- Inspect and repair equipment to ensure safety and functionality
- Prepare and set up equipment for practices and games
- Assist players / coaches
- Provide on-site support for any equipment related issues during games / practices
- Work closely with coaches and Team Officials
- Perform any other appropriate duties as assigned by EC or required by IIHF

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Good command of written and spoken English or Chinese
- Attend / manage all scheduled practices / games / off ice sessions / classroom sessions (if any) in Hong Kong is preferred
